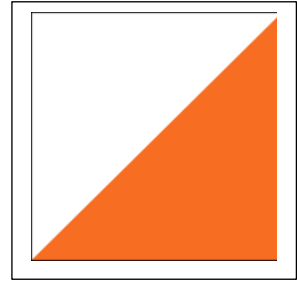


Virtual Orienteering Bewdley



This can be done in any order, the numbers on here just relate to the locations on the map. Below are some hints to help you out when at the location to find the control (top right). The controls all have some letters on and all or some will be used to create a word related to Bewdley (hint below).

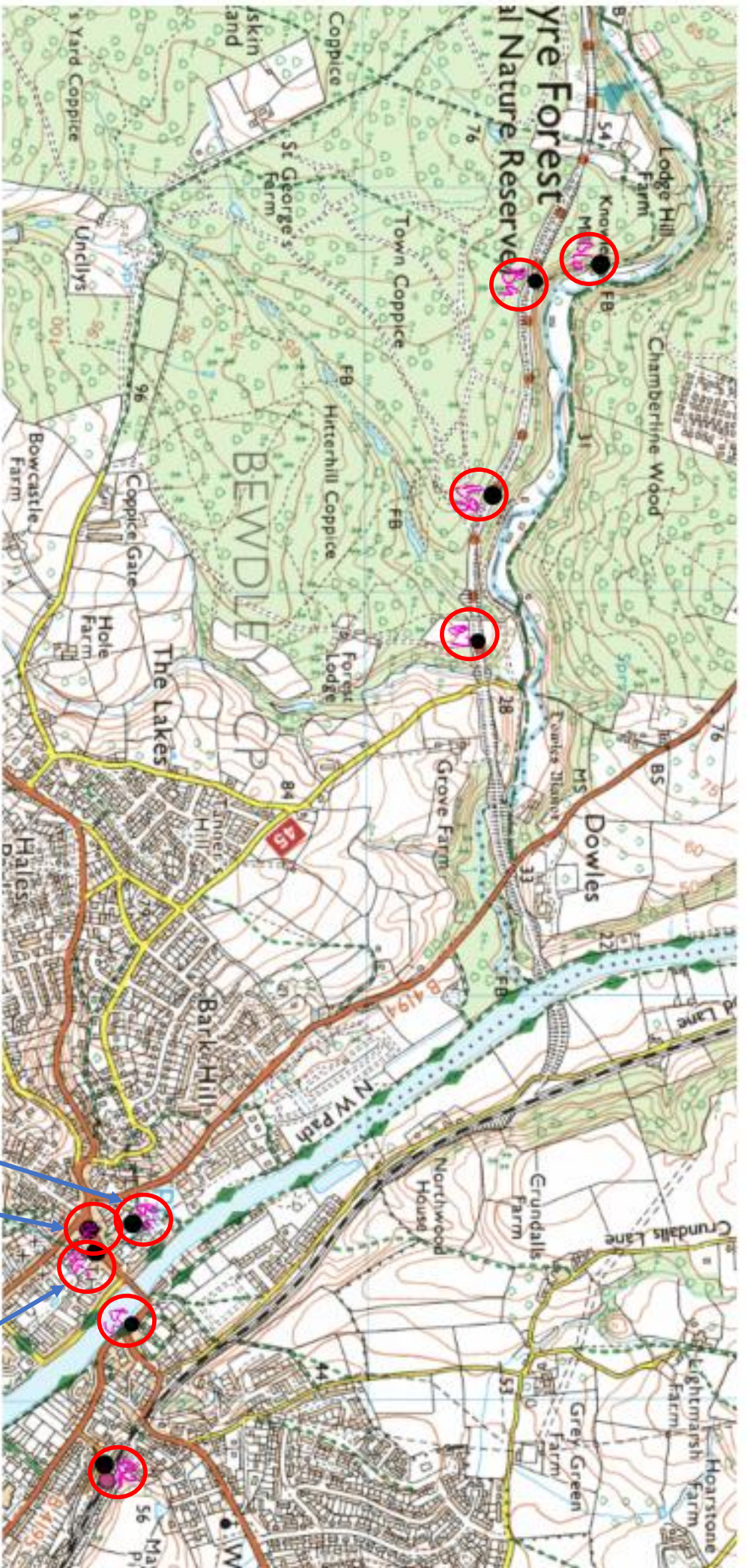
Locations

- B1) Blackstone – Where would you look to plan a route for your walk?
- B2) Severn Valley Station – I'm very old and tall if you find me then turn around and what you are looking for is located on a sign for a place you may like to eat.
- B3) Bridge – If you're on the bridge you have gone to far. The control is located on a sign where you might find elephants.
- B4) Old Fire Station – on green opposite
- B5) Museum – Grey box = 12
- B6) Church – whoops sign
- B7) Dry Mill Lane Carpark – Think about what birds you may see
- B8) Trail Sign - Learn about the beautiful symmetric insects you may encounter on your walk.
- B9) Coppice Nature Reserve – Back sign
- B10) Knowles Mill – Take a seat. Look under.
